Chamber Music for Collegiate Players

CMI has a program designed especially for college-aged string players. Participants in this program receive expert coaching, the opportunity to play in a chamber ensemble with other high-level players, and work on challenging chamber music.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Please contact the Program Director, Neil Aaronson (astanj.cmi@gmail.com), before registering as a collegiate player for CMI 2015.
- Collegiate players must have at least one semester (or the equivalent) of college *and* be at least 18 years of age at the time of the CMI. Any exceptions must be approved by Program Director, Neil Aaronson.
- Participants in the CMI collegiate program are expected to attend all morning and afternoon chamber music coaching sessions; the Wednesday evening run-through; all guest coaching sessions; master classes on Thursday; and the Friday evening concert.
- Collegiate players will be provided with lunch each day, and for dinner on Wednesday.
- Collegiate players will not be provided with a dorm room and are expected to commute to the CMI each day.
- Every effort will be made to place collegiate players in ensembles with other collegiate players. In some cases, it may be necessary to include talented younger players in collegiate ensembles, or collegiate players in ensembles made up of talented younger players.
- Collegiate players must pay the \$50 registration fee, plus \$500 tuition per session of CMI.
- Collegiate players who have not previously attended CMI must audition via YouTube video in the same manner as other CMI applicants.
- Collegiate players must register and submit their registration fee by June 1, 2015. Tuition must be paid in full before July 1st, 2015.
