Videos must be labeled with the following information: name of applicant, phone number of applicant, title and character name for both monologues and/or songs. Please make sure the videotape is appropriately packed (bubble wrap or the like). Prospective students do NOT need to introduce themselves and/or their work as part of the recording. After viewing of your tape, you will be called and an interview will be conducted over the telephone.

Audition/Interview: Local students, who are available for a personal audition and interview, please check all Saturdays that the student is available to be at the New Brunswick, New Jersey campus.
