

Declaration of Minor

Mason Gross School of the Arts students may declare and complete a minor in a liberal arts field, along with their B.F.A. or B.Mus. program. Students pursuing this option will still receive a B.F.A. or B.Mus. degree; their transcripts will also indicate the completion of a minor in a liberal arts subject. This option does not provide for the declaration of a second degree, nor does it permit Mason Gross students to complete the liberal arts version of a Mason Gross minor. This means that a Mason Gross student completing a B.F.A. in visual arts can also complete a liberal arts minor in Psychology, for example, but cannot complete a minor in dance, music, or theater arts. The Mason Gross major field of study will remain the priority toward graduation. In order to receive your diploma, the requirements for both the Mason Gross degree and minor must be completed before graduation.

Procedures:

- A minor in a liberal arts area can be declared at any time.
- Students interested in pursuing a minor must complete this declaration form upon reviewing course requirements with the supporting liberal arts department (see other side).
- The supporting liberal arts department sets forth the minor requirements on the declaration form and signs for approval. Students pursuing a minor must satisfy all department requirements, including stipulated grade requirements, to complete the minor.
- Once the department for the minor has approved the student's proposal, return this completed form to the Mason Gross School of the Arts Dean of Students, who will certify the minor. The minor will be noted on the student's transcript by the Undergraduate Registrar's Office.
- All requirements for the B.F.A. or B.Mus. and minor must be completed at the time of graduation in order to receive your diploma.
