\*\*Dance Production - students may take either fall or spring semester during their junior year. Ballet 6 is required for two semesters – students may continue to take Ballet 6 as elective credit beyond the two-semester requirement.

\*\*\* These courses also fulfill liberal arts requirements

Dance Rotation Workshop is required for 7 semesters (total of 3.5 credits). If a student fails Dance Rotation Workshop, the student must take Dance Rotation Workshop their senior spring semester.

**Students must earn a C or better in required courses or repeat the course.**

**Students must be registered for a minimum of 12 credits each semester to achieve full-time status.**
