# Music Education Vocal/General - Performance Double (Piano Majors) Concentration Notes

- Students must refer to the Requirement Checklist for each concentration for a complete list of all required courses. The Sample
  Schedule indicates a distribution that works in terms of avoiding scheduling conflicts and should not be used as a Requirement Checklist.
  Some music courses in the Sample Schedule may be taken in other semesters, however, any changes to the suggested distribution
  must be discussed with and approved by your advisor. Please note that not all courses are offered every semester or every year.
- 2. Expository Writing (01:355:101) is required and must be taken in the Spring semester of the first year of enrollment. The initial writing placement is determined by a Basic Skills test. Students who are placed in a lower-level writing course **must** take that course in the Fall semester of the first year. Students who do not pass a level of the required writing course(s) must complete that level in the immediate next semester of enrollment.
- 3. It is recommended that the required Liberal Arts Math course be completed in the first year.
- 4. The required Liberal Arts courses are shown here as ten 3-credit courses, distributed for balance among the semesters before *Clinical Practice II*. Other distributions are possible, and many Music Education majors decide to take some of these courses in the summer.
- 5. One or more sections of *Special Studies in Music History* (700:419 or 700:420) will be offered every semester. Each section will have a different topic, and the topics will change from semester to semester. Either course satisfies the Liberal Arts Humanities Area.
- 6. Choral Music Education Lab I (700:287) and Choral Music Education Lab II (700:387) are offered in the fall semester of even-numbered years. 287 is taken in either the first or second year; 387 is taken in the third or fourth year.
- 7. Materials & Methods in Elementary School Music (700:381) is taken in the fall semester of the third year, and Materials and Methods in Secondary Choral Music (700:382) is taken in the spring semester of the third year.
- 8. Piano majors in performance are required to take a minimum of two semesters of *Art of Accompanying* (07:701:351-352) and two semesters of *Studio Accompaniment* (07:701:451-452). Once a minimum of 4 semesters of *Large Ensemble* have been fulfilled, these four semesters may be counted towards either the large ensemble requirement or the chamber music requirement.
- 9. Piano Pedagogy (07:701:459-460) is a two-semester requirement.
- 10. Vocal Coaching is required in the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> years.
