INSTRUCTIONS FOR INDEPENDENT STUDIES

An **Independent Study** involves working closely with a faculty advisor for one semester on a specific research-driven project of the student's own devising. Before beginning an Independent Study, the student must:

- a) Identify a <u>full-time</u> faculty member willing to mentor the student's Independent Study.
- b) Complete and submit an **Independent Study Proposal form**, specifying the nature of the research and the work to be accomplished.
- c) Obtain the faculty mentor's approval of the proposal.

An Independent Study is considered a Studio elective, and counts for two credits. It is usually undertaken in Junior or Senior year and may be taken up to two times.
